


Dispenser Placement in the OR

With only 18% compliance for hygienic hand disinfection in anesthesia, better placement of disinfectants in the OR is strongly recommended [1].



3 tips for dispenser placement

Focus on the perspective of the staff:

Dispensers should always be visible during a treatment [2].

One arm's length distance:

Personnel should not have to move to reach the dispenser during the activity.

Ensure functionality:

Regular control of the functionality as well as of the expiration date and the filling level of the hand disinfectant [4].



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
